

Sex and Marriage as proscribed by Yahawah
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Yahawah ba ha sham Yahawashi

Sex is not just a pleasure principle for one to enjoy at his/her will. Men and women today indulge in sex with just a lust to fulfill a selfish desire of their physical appetite. Often there is not even any real love involved. All men that do such are whoremongers and women are whores according to the world of Yahawah. Many of you have used sex just to please one's self and you do not use sex for the purpose for which Yahawah designed it. What was Yahawah's purpose when he designed sex to be pleasurable experience?

His purpose was that the act of sex be fore both marrying and bringing a child into this world, and that this would derive from a very pleasurable experience. Yet sex can often become as drug and many of you have over dosed on this and degenerated to beast in human form. The world in which we live have become so degenerate that women often state" if the man can do it I can too" Yet this is wrong sisters. A woman can only marry

once therefore sisters be extremely careful in selecting your mate. Because you only get one chance. There are many smooth talking brothers that know the scriptures and how to entice you with words. Once you lie down and have sex with that man he becomes your husband and you can never remarry unless he dies. If you do remarry you commit adultery if he is still alive. Brothers you can not put a women away because she does not keep a clean house or because you just got tired of her sexually and want another or because she messed up the dinner.

I would like to make one thing very clear sister, if a man divorce you this does not mean you can remarry. If you remarry you commit adultery. Furthermore one cannot divorce unless there is unlawful sex; **Matthew 19: 3]** “The Pharisees also came unto him, tempting him, and saying unto him, Is it lawful for a man to put away his wife for every cause?

[4] And he answered and said unto them, Have ye not read, that he which made them at the beginning made them male and female,

[5] And said, For this cause shall a man leave father and mother, and shall cleave to his wife: and they twain shall be one flesh?

[6] Wherefore they are no more twain, but one flesh. What therefore God hath joined together, let not man put asunder.

[7] They say unto him, Why did Moses then command to give a writing of divorcement, and to put her away?

[8] He saith unto them, Moses because of the hardness of your hearts suffered you to put away your wives: but from the beginning it was not so.

[9] And I say unto you, Whosoever shall put away his wife, except it be for fornication, and shall marry another, committeth adultery: and whoso marrieth her which is put away doth commit adultery. This world in which we live has resulted in the daughters of Zion playing the whore”. In verses 7 and 8, Jesus says the divorce bill was a provision given because of their sinfulness, "but from the beginning it was not so." Then in verse 9, He gives the biblical standard;

9 "And I say to you, whoever divorces his wife, except for sexual immorality, and marries another, commits adultery; and whoever marries her who is divorced commits adultery."

Divorce was not permitted "except" in the case of **fornication**. This is the one and only ground for two Israelites getting divorced

Matthew 5: 31] “It hath been said, Whosoever shall put away his wife, let him give her a writing of divorcement:

[32] But I say unto you, That whosoever shall put away his wife, saving for the cause of fornication,(fornication is unlawful sex not sex before marriage this scriptures clearly proves that. This women is already his wife so how than can fornication be sex before marriage) causeth her to commit adultery: and whosoever shall marry her that is divorced committeth adultery”. Yahawashi here is narrowing the standard to one exception-- fornication. In verse 31, Yahawashi refers to Israel's official divorce bill used by the Jews for about 14 centuries. **Leviticus 20:10 (NKJV)** 'The man who commits

adultery with another man's wife, he who commits adultery with his neighbor's wife, the adulterer and the adulteress, shall surely be put to death.

Many Israelites use the law of divorce and became wicked with its missuse. Watch this

Deut.24[1]" When a man hath taken a wife, and married her, and it come to pass that she find no favour in his eyes, because he hath found some uncleanness in her: then let him write her a bill of divorcement, and give it in her hand, and send her out of his house.

[2] And when she is departed out of his house, she may go and be another man's wife.

[3] And if the latter husband hate her, and write her a bill of divorcement, and giveth it in her hand, and sendeth her out of his house; or if the latter husband die, which took her to be his wife;

[4] Her former husband, which sent her away, may not take her again to be his wife, after that she is defiled; for that is abomination before the LORD: and thou shalt not cause the land to sin, which the LORD thy God giveth thee for an inheritance".

The only way a woman is justified in remarriage is fornication or adultery on her husband's behalf that is the women above was able to remarry. If fornication was not involved the women can not remarry. Divorce was widespread throughout Palestine when Christ uttered the words of Matthew 5:32. People were divorcing for every cause.

John 4:16-18 (NKJV) Jesus said to her, "Go, call your husband, and come here." 17 The woman answered and said, "I have no husband." Jesus said to her, "You have well said, 'I have no husband,' 18 "for you have had five husbands, and the one whom you now have is not your husband; in that you spoke truly."

This woman was not an exceptional case. Yahawashi seems to have given recognition to the legality of the fact that the woman had been married to five husbands, but the man she was living with was "not her husband." This is a clear distinction of marital status. Why was he not her husband because fornication was not involved.

In Matthew 5:32, our [Christ shows that the man who divorces his wife for any cause except fornication causes her to commit adultery in re-marriage](#). Yahawashi assumed that the woman would remarry. The reason she commits adultery is that she becomes involved in sexual sin with another man while still the wife of the man who divorced her. [The divorce did not dissolve the marriage](#). She was still his wife and he was still her husband. [The woman did not have the right to re-marriage](#). Again while Yahawah allowed a man to take more than one wife he can not put away his wife to take another.

In this case, an undissolved marriage is clearly in view. The divorce renders the couple still married. The question of dissolution is at the heart of the matter. If the husband put away his wife for fornication, the case is different. The marriage is dissolved and the man is not involved in the sin that the woman commits.

Under Mosaic law, marriage was held so sacred that both the betrothed bride and adulterous wife were put to death for unfaithfulness (Deut. 22:23-24).

So, when a person divorces for fornication, they are free to remarry.

What exactly is "fornication?" Fornication and adultery are synonymous terms in the scriptures and they are often interchangeable. In Hebrew and Greek, fornication includes; incest, sodomy, harlotry, perversion and all sexual sin both before and after marriage. The Greek word for "fornication" is porneia.

1 Corinthians 10:8 (NKJV) "Nor let us commit sexual immorality, as some of them did, and in one day twenty-three thousand fell"

All of you black men out her that have sex with your boy's girlfriend are causing her and you to commit adultery if you have a so-called girlfriend because sex constitutes marriage. **Matthew 19: 3]** "The Pharisees also came unto him, tempting him, and saying unto him, Is it lawful for a man to put away his wife for every cause?
[4] And he answered and said unto them, Have ye not read, that he which made them at the beginning made them male and female,
[5] And said, For this cause shall a man leave father and mother, and shall cleave to his wife: and they twain shall be one flesh? (the act of sex is marriage)
[6] Wherefore they are no more twain, but one flesh. What therefore God hath joined together, let not man put asunder". What Yahawashi is saying here is once you have that act of sex which constitutes marriage do not be seeking to undo that.

Let's look at this in the old testaments **Genesis 4: 1]** And Adam knew Eve his wife; and she conceived, and bare Cain, and said, I have gotten a man from the LORD. Where was the ordained minister her? There was none when Adam knew Eve(had sex with her) she became his wife. **Genesis 24: [64]** "And Rebekah lifted up her eyes, and when she saw Isaac, she lighted off the camel. **[65]** For she had said unto the servant, What man is this that walketh in the field to meet us? And the servant had said, It is my master: therefore she took a vail, and covered herself.**[66]** And the servant told Isaac all things that he had done.**[67]** And Isaac brought her into his mother Sarah's tent, and took Rebekah, and she became his wife; and he loved her: and Isaac was comforted after his mother's death". Let look at another scripture",

Gen.30[1] And when Rachel saw that she bare Jacob no children, Rachel envied her sister; and said unto Jacob, Give me children, or else I die.
[2] And Jacob's anger was kindled against Rachel: and he said, Am I in God's stead, who hath withheld from thee the fruit of the womb?
[3] And she said, Behold my maid Bilhah, go in unto her; and she shall bear upon my knees that I may also have children by her.
[4] And she gave him Bilhah her handmaid to wife: and Jacob went in unto her.

[5] And Bilhah conceived, and bare Jacob a son. Yet, again this reveals that the act of sex constitutes marriage.

Another issue is that many of you are using condoms, birth control, murder know as abortions and these depro shots to destroy the holy seed from entering your wombs.

Genesis 30: [2] **“And Jacob's anger was kindled against Rachel: and he said, Am I in God's stead, who hath withheld from thee the fruit of the womb?”**

It is not for you to prevent yourselves from having children. Yahawah is the one that has the power of the womb. We are not to try to stand in the place of Yahawah and dictate when we are going to have children. That is not your decision that is Yahawah's decision. He is the one that allows a women to get pregnant, every time that you have sex you do not get pregnant showing you that this is not under the power of man.

Let us now look at the law how sex constitutes marriage, Exodus 22: 16]” And he that stealeth a man, and selleth him, or if he be found in his hand, he shall surely be put to death”. You marriage vows are to the Most High brothers and sister as well as yourselves. When you attempt to dissolve this because that person did not live up to your expectations you are going against a vow that you have taken with Yahawah.

Tobit 6: 15] “Then the angel said unto him, Dost thou not remember the precepts which thy father gave thee, that thou shouldest marry a wife of thine own kindred? wherefore hear me, O my brother; for she shall be given thee to wife; and make thou no reckoning of the evil spirit; for this same night shall she be given thee in marriage.(the evil spirit kept coming because this woman was created to Tobias)

[16] And when thou shalt come into the marriage chamber,...

Tobit 8: [4] “And after that they were both shut in together, Tobias rose out of the bed, and said, Sister, arise, and let us pray that God would have pity on us.

[5] Then began Tobias to say, Blessed art thou, O God of our fathers, and blessed is thy holy and glorious name for ever; let the heavens bless thee, and all thy creatures.

[6] Thou madest Adam, and gavest him Eve his wife for an helper and stay: of them came mankind: thou hast said, It is not good that man should be alone; let us make unto him an aid like unto himself.

[7] And now, O Lord, I take not this my sister for lush but uprightly: therefore mercifully ordain that we may become aged together.

[8] And she said with him, Amen”. The word of the Most High is clear the act of sex constitutes marriage. The ceremonial part was just a celebration with your people.

Marriage is supposed to be forever and Most high hates divorce. Malachi 2: 15] “And did not he make one? Yet had he the residue of the spirit. And wherefore one? That he might seek a godly seed. Therefore take heed to your spirit, and let none deal treacherously against the wife of his youth.

[16] For the LORD, the God of Israel, saith that he hateth putting away: for one covereth violence with his garment, saith the LORD of hosts: therefore take heed to your spirit, that ye deal not treacherously”. Its clear that Yahawah hates putting away(divorce). Brothers and sister I reiterate once you have that act of sex and you put that women away except it is for adultery/fornication you commit adultery. **Mark 10: 2]” And the Pharisees**

came to him, and asked him, Is it lawful for a man to put away his wife? tempting him.
 [3] And he answered and said unto them, What did Moses command you?
 [4] And they said, Moses suffered to write a bill of divorcement, and to put her away.
 [5] And Jesus answered and said unto them, For the hardness of your heart he wrote you this precept.
 [6] But from the beginning of the creation God made them male and female.
 [7] For this cause shall a man leave his father and mother, and cleave to his wife;
 [8] And they twain shall be one flesh: so then they are no more twain, but one flesh.
 [9] What therefore God hath joined together, let not man put asunder.
 [10] And in the house his disciples asked him again of the same matter.
 [11] And he saith unto them, Whosoever shall put away his wife, and marry another, committeth adultery against her.
 [12] And if a woman shall put away her husband, and be married to another, she committeth adultery”.

Brothers you cannot put away one wife to marry another. Sister you cannot go out and remarry. 1st Corinthians 7: 10] “And unto the married I command, yet not I, but the Lord, Let not the wife depart from her husband” Romans 7: [2] “For the woman which hath an husband is bound by the law to her husband so long as he liveth; but if the husband be dead, she is loosed from the law of her husband.” Many of you will not abide by this yet you profess to believe in he Most High. It is not for you to pick and chose which laws that you will abide by. You wan to follow the so-called white mans policies and divorce your husband sisters you will be judge accordingly. 1st Corinthians 3: [19] “For the wisdom of this world is foolishness with God. For it is written, He taketh the wise in their own craftiness”. The things that was occurring during the time of Noah is what is occurring right now, Matthew 24: 37] “But as the days of Noe were, so shall also the coming of the Son of man be.

[38] For as in the days that were before the flood they were eating and drinking, marrying and giving in marriage, until the day that Noe entered into the ark” As we look back at the law we discover that marriage is suppose to be about love, not lust and I want to hit that. Genesis 24: 67] “And Isaac brought her into his mother Sarah's tent, and took Rebekah,(had sex with her, married her) and she became his wife; and he loved her: and Isaac was comforted after his mother's death”. My next point is that many of you hypocrites do not want o have children because you do not want he responsibility to feeding, clothing and caring the children. It is not for you to decide that you will not have children. Women you cannot have your tubes tied, or get on birth control or use condoms. What is the first commandment that Yahawah gave us in the bible? Many of you assume that you know the scriptures but if the holy spirit is not working with you will need help in understanding this truth.

Lets get the first commandment we were given by Yahawah. Genesis 1: 27] “So God created man in his own image, in the image of God created he him; male and female created he them.

[28] And God blessed them, and God said unto them, **Be fruitful, and multiply, and replenish** the earth, and subdue it: and have dominion over the fish of the sea, and over

the fowl of the air, and over every” This is the first order that Yahawah gave us, why do you think that you have the seed in you? It is to procreate life.

Genesis 22: 16] “And said, By myself have I sworn, saith the LORD, for because thou hast done this thing, and hast not withheld thy son, thine only son:
[17] That in blessing I will bless thee, and in multiplying I will multiply thy seed as the stars of the heaven, and as the sand which is upon the sea shore; and thy seed shall possess the gate of his enemies”

Now let me give you an example of a selfish man that did not want to carry out Yahawah’s order because the seed would not carry his name yet his brother’s name because his brother’s wife was a widow. **Genesis 38: 8]** “And Judah said unto Onan, Go in unto thy brother's wife, and marry her, and raise up seed to thy brother. **9]** And Onan knew that the seed should not be his; and it came to pass, when he went in unto his brother's wife, that he spilled it on the ground, lest that he should give seed to his brother”. We are suppose to have children and multiply even within our captivity.

Jer 29:4] “Thus saith the LORD of hosts, the God of Israel, unto all that are carried away captives, whom I have caused to be carried away from Jerusalem unto Babylon;
[5] Build ye houses, and dwell in them; and plant gardens, and eat the fruit of them;
[6] Take ye wives, and beget sons and daughters; and take wives for your sons, and give your daughters to husbands, that they may bear sons and daughters; that ye may be increased there, and not diminished.” Please return to the Most High and keep his laws whole heartedly.

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
